## **Class Prerequisites:**

- 1. Locate and plot an object by Latitude and Longitude in Degrees, minutes and seconds.
- 2. Measure distance on a chart, chart datum and correct for height of tide from the GPS almanac.
- 3. Utilize and retrieve data from Local Notice to Mariners and the Light List.
- 4. Read the material from the <u>NS website</u> on the <u>PATON</u> and <u>Aids Verifier</u> tabs (links).
- 5. Print out the <u>AV Qualification</u> Guide from <u>NS website</u> and complete the self study and resource tasks.
- 6. If you need a navigation refresher, take your flotilla's BS&S course this winter.
