May 15 Session - Training Topics:

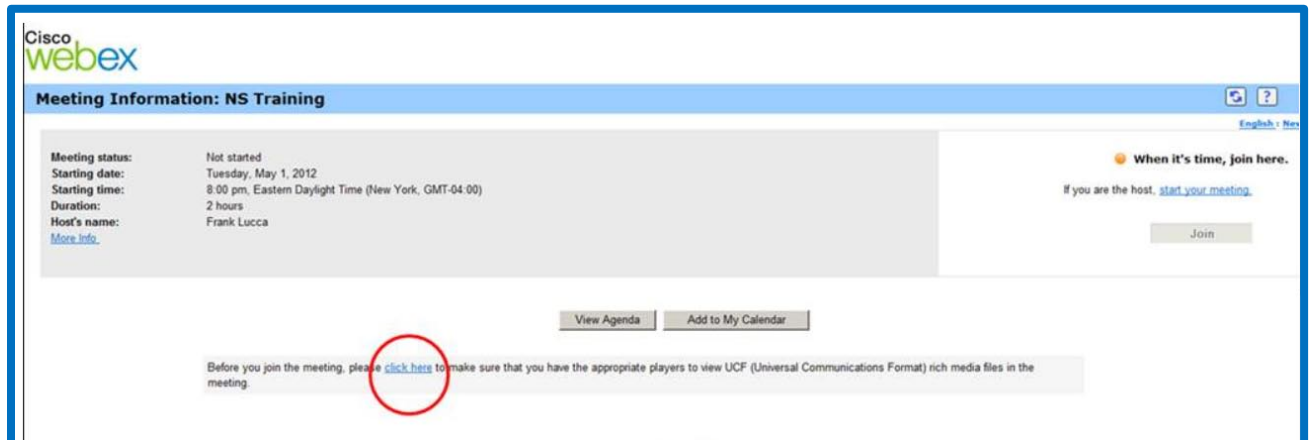
- ***How to register on the On-Line PATON System*** – 15 minutes.
 - AVs will learn how to register and receive access codes to the PATON System.
- ***How a PATON Owner applies for a PATON Permit and prepares an application on-line*** - 20 minutes.
 - It is important to understand how easy it is to apply for a Private Aid permit on-line which is a requirement in the First District.
- ***Review of the features of the Standard AV PATON System screen.*** – 15 minutes.
 - You will learn how to search and sort the system PATON list and prepare EXCEL spreadsheets, One Page Verification Reports and to understand the implication and meaning of each data column.
- ***How to access and prepare a “7054 AV Verification Report on-line*** – 35 minutes.
 - Each field and drop down menu on this report is explained. You will learn how to add photos and how to prepare an on-line AUXDATA 7030 Activity report.
- ***How Aquaculture Facilities should be documented and reported.*** – 20 minutes.

WebEX training sessions are limited to 25 people.

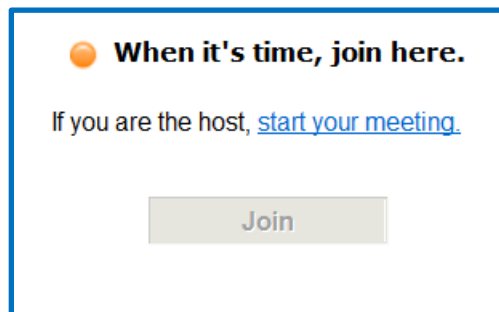
Step 1 - Click the new **WebEX** page on the NS Web Site at: www.uscgaan.com.
